Overview

Pregnant women and mothers of young children face special challenges when seeking recovery from substance use disorders.

Kaleidoscope Recovery Services addresses those barriers by connecting them with community-based resources and treatment.

Who We Serve

Kaleidoscope Recovery Services supports mothers who have small children under the age of six. To be eligible for the program, they must have a substance use disorder and want to receive recovery support.

Family Needs

Our interventions address family needs such as:

- Substance use disorders
- Long-term recovery strategies
- Integrated care
- Risk of a youth's removal from the home
- Navigating multiple systems
- Mental health
- Complex trauma
- Neglect



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How It Works



A therapist, care coordinator, and recovery specialist are assigned to each family.



Crisis intervention is available 24/7 to address safety issues and prevent unnecessary placement of a child.



Services may last from 6-9 months depending on family needs. Larger families or families with more complex needs may require longer periods of service.



The care coordinator and therapist help with safety and crisis planning, and crisis management when needed. Services are delivered in the mother's home or community. We help her further develop life and social skills, while helping her strengthen her natural support system.



Through partnerships with community organizations and providers, we offer care coordination, intensive outpatient treatment, peer support, coordination for Medication-Assisted Treatment (MAT), mental health services, childcare, and vocational support. We address social determinants of health to improve participants' well-being and quality of life.



The care coordinator helps families with concrete services like housing, jobs, and education. The family further develops their life and social skills and strengthens their natural support system. The care coordinator connects them with community resources, youth activities, and drug-free recreation for parents.
